What is the Fast Forward Program?

Fast Forward offers students an opportunity to prepare to go directly from high school into the workforce, college certifications or apprenticeship programs. Students take courses toward a 30 credit Ontario Secondary School Graduation diploma.

It is a program that meets the needs of students who:

- struggle with literacy and numeracy skills
- had modifications to their program in elementary school
- may benefit from skills-based programming that focuses on developing practical and employability skills
- are working below grade level.

Fast Forward prepares students by:

- providing “hands-on” training for a specific industry
- teaching communication and interpersonal skills
- building student self-confidence through personal success
- providing a solid foundation for lifelong learning
- preparing students for rewarding careers and promising futures
- providing opportunities both inside and outside of the classroom environment (eg. coop, field trips)
